Campus Updates:

- A well for the main lodge was drilled, with a flow rate of 15 gpm
- Donated ICF blocks were delivered for the main lodge, ready for installation
- Site-plan agreement was finalized with the city of Belleville
- Permit review and finalization for main lodge building plans will be completed soon
- Trent Schutt will join the team mid-May, taking a lead role in the construction of the main lodge.
